These units plug into a mains socket and standard telephone outlet and the resident is provided with a pendant transmitter – worn as brooch, wrist or neck trigger. The transmitter, or a button on the Sayphone 21 unit itself, can initiate calls to a central station, if help is required.

Compatible with the full range of Altec telecare and telehealth peripherals using EN300 220-2 (2007) Class 1 receivers, this is supported by the recently ratified and TSA endorsed BS 8521 protocol

BS 8521 offers – for the first time – the promise of improved interoperability of remote controllers supplied by different manufacturers, better identification and localisation of alarms and events and a solution which is resilient in the telecommunications network environment post 2010.



The **SayPhone V2** retains the alarm signalling capabilities of traditional dispersed alarm units to ensure compatibility with existing Alarm Receiving Centres and offers true telecare facilities as standard.

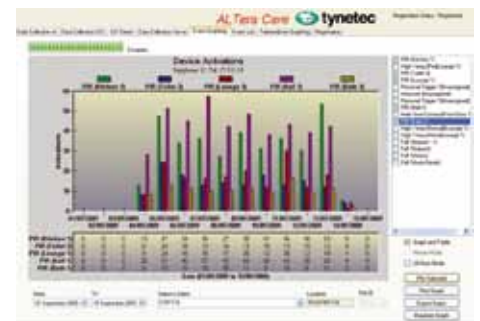
