The DDA affects a wide range of organisations and markets including construction, housing and retail – where entrances must be accessible to all and at the same time, ensuring reliable, trouble-free operation.

#### **BS 7036 regulations**

These regulations require all automatic doors to be maintained at 6 monthly intervals to ensure that the doors are operating at their optimal performance and that all safety systems are operating correctly.

Although the BS 7036 is not law, it would be used in any incident involving an automatic door that ended up in court.

However, using ADSA approved engineers, you can be sure that the standards of safety, quality, reliability and after-sales service to both specifiers and users, are met.
